Japanese Society of Pediatric Dentistry Travel Award for Young Researchers from Developing Countries

The award is aimed at young researchers in Paediatric Dentistry requesting to present their work and gain insight from their peers in the field. The award will facilitate the attendance of the recipient at the IAPD 2nd Global Summit 2020. The award is generously sponsored by the Japanese Society of Pediatric Dentistry (JSPD). Two awards of up to 400,000 JPN each will be available. This is approximately US\$3,600 to cover airfare, four nights' accommodation and registration.

RULES

1. This travel grant is restricted to young researchers travelling to the IAPD Global Summit Meeting from Developing Countries as defined by the World Bank which include Low income (L) countries or Lower middle-income (LM) countries (See <https://datatopics.worldbank.org/world-development-indicators/the-world-by-income-and-region.html> for a list of eligible countries or contact IAPD secretariat).
2. Applicants must:
 - a) Be current members of the IAPD;
 - b) Be a postgraduate student or postdoctoral- level researcher or dentist working in the field of paediatric dentistry;
 - c) Be no older than 40 on January 1st 2020;
 - d) Perform clinical or scientific research in the field of paediatric dentistry.
3. Applicants should write a letter to the IAPD Secretariat (iapd@iapdworld.org) stating how the JSPD award would be particularly helpful to them.
4. Applicants shall be eligible for a travel bursary of up to 400,000 JPN (Four hundred thousand Japanese Yens) to cover airfare, four nights' accommodation and registration. The early registration fee of the Meeting will apply for the winners of the JSPD Travel Awards.
5. Each application should be accompanied by a copy of a poster abstract and research essay submitted to the Congress.
6. Each application should be accompanied by short Curriculum Vitae. It is optional to send a letter of support from a supervisor or senior colleague.
7. All applications will be reviewed by the JSPD Awards Committee.
8. Awardees shall only be eligible to receive the travel bursary once.
9. Candidates are not eligible for another prize at the Congress.
10. The presence of the recipient at the Closing ceremony is mandatory.

12. The Award winners are chosen four months prior to the Global Summit to help the winners cover their expenses, however, payment will be done to the awardees after the Summit Meeting by wire transfer. Winners will be contacted and requested to submit banking details to the Secretariat.
